We live in turbulent times and the storms of life such as work problems, retrenchment, relationship conflicts, tension at home hit us constantly, disrupting our lives and destroying our health, our sense of security. So long as we are in this world, we can expect to face all kinds of trials and tribulations.

The bible assures us that we are not alone in our crisis as God is with us and will empower us to overcome our struggles. The apostle Paul encouraged the early believers in Romans 8: 37 that: "In all these things we are more than conquerors through Him who loved us."

What does it mean to put our faith in God and to live like conquerors in times like this? The course will look at:
