The Anglican Church of Burundi

There are at least 900,000 Anglicans out of an estimated population of just over 9 million in Burundi. An Anglican presence was established through the work of Christian Missionary Society (CMS) in the 1930s and grew rapidly as a result of the East African Revival. The Province of the Anglican Church of Burundi came into existence in 1992. It covers the whole of Burundi and it has nine dioceses.

- Pray for the Church's major concerns addressing peace and reconciliation, advocacy, education, health, literacy and financial education, and community development. It is committed to mission and evangelism and is concerned to support theological education and training for ministry. Working together at Provincial and diocesan level, the Church is seeking through its activities, programmes and projects to impact people's lives with God's saving, redeeming and transforming love.
- Pray for the provincial and diocesan staff work as they work together to develop, manage and monitor activities, and secure funding.
