Lectionary Morning Prayer Readings

"COME AWAY WITH ME" A CONTEMPLATIVE RETREAT 12 – 14 September 2024 Montfort Retreat Centre

Be still, and know that I am God (Psalm 46:10)

Are you tired? Worn out? Burned out on religion? Come to Me. Get away with Me and you'll recover your life. I'll show you how to take a real rest. Walk with Me and work with Me — watch how I do it. Learn the unforced rhythms of grace. I won't lay anything heavy or ill-fitting on you. Keep company with Me and you'll learn to live freely and lightly. (Matthew 11:28-30, Message)

Many of us live hurry-packed schedules and come under constant pressure to perform, achieve and deliver. Such kind of life is unsustainable if we do not set aside regular time to rest, be refreshed, and reconnect with God. Hence, Jesus is always inviting us to "come away by yourselves..." (Mark 6:31) and "I will give you rest" (Matt 11:28).

As Jan Johnson reminds us, "A retreat as extended Sabbath renews us as we experience solitude and play at a slower rhythm, allowing God more space to interact with us." You are thus invited to set aside some time to enter into a scared space at this retreat, to pause and reflect, to commune and listen to God, in an undistracted, quiet and restful environment. There will be guided sessions in practising the spiritual disciplines as well as times for contemplative silence during this retreat.

Retreat Director

Before answering God's call to full-time pastoral ministry, Stanley Tay worked in the petrochemical industry for 14 years. He joined the pastoral staff team at St. John's – St. Margaret's Church (SJSM) in 2005 after obtaining a Master in Christian Studies (Spiritual Theology) from Regent College, Canada. He left the team in early 2021 to pursue a Doctor of Ministry at Fuller Theological Seminary, with a focus on Spiritual Direction & Formation. He is now in year 4 of this 5-year program.

Stanley continues to preach and teach in different churches, and is currently an adjunct lecturer in the School of Counselling at Singapore Bible College. He also provides spiritual direction, leads contemplative retreats locally and spiritual pilgrimages to the Holy Land and UK.
