

ARCHBISHOP'S MESSAGE 2025

Dear brothers and sisters in Christ,

As we enter a new year, we find ourselves in a world that is mired in conflict and hostility. From Wall Street to the United Nations, from the Middle East to Ukraine, the very foundation of our culture and society is being shaken in a way that we have not witnessed in many years. We in the Province of South East Asia are by no means spared from the effects of this global distress and unrest.

Within our own Communion, various issues that are being discussed and debated have the potential to divide the Church. Within our Province, the demographics of our own members continue to trend inexorably older. And yet, even as we face many formidable and seemingly insurmountable challenges, we find our hope and strength in the words of our Lord in the gospel of St John 16:33, "I have said these things to you, that in me you may have peace. In the world you will have tribulation. But take heart; I have overcome the world."

These words remind us that we need to look to the Lord for the answer to our plight and that now, more than ever, we have to bend our knees and turn our faces to God in prayer. Specifically, we should pray for peace in our war-torn world, and for peace in our Province that is undergirded by Christian love and unity.

We should also pray for courage to love in the midst of adversity. Pray that the turbulence that surround us become an opportunity to bear witness with overwhelming compassion and charity so that the hope of Christ may cast a light into the darkness of the world. To quote Eusebius' testimony of the Christians under the oppression of emperor Maximus: "For they alone in the midst of such ills showed their sympathy and humanity by their deeds. ... so that the thing became noised abroad among all men, and they glorified the God of the Christians, and convinced by the facts themselves, they admitted that Christians were truly pious and the only god-fearing people."

We should also pray for the many men and women who labour fervently for the building of God's church and the proclamation of the gospel in these pressing times. Let us pray that they may be refreshed in spirit and renewed in their zeal, knowing that their toil is not in vain for the stars shine brightest when the night is darkest. We have a need for those who are able to receive the baton from current leaders and so we ask that the Lord would raise up godly men and women for this task.

Brothers and sisters in Christ, let us not lose hope but press on, trusting in our God who will see us through. "But since we belong to the day, let us be sober, having put on the breastplate of faith and love, and for a helmet the hope of salvation... He who calls you is faithful; he will surely do it." (1 Thessalonians 5)

May the Lord's peace and strength be upon all of us. Amen.

- At the 33rd Diocesan Synod meeting, the Synod had unanimously passed a resolution to create 3 area dioceses within the Diocese of Sabah. We praise and thank the Lord for this milestone decision to strategize growth, expand leadership base, empower laity, and enhance pastoral care of clergy and pastors.
- We give thanks to God for the faithful services of clergy and pastors who have retired or are retiring, especially The Venerable Moses Chin (retired in December 2024) and The Venerable Lidis Singkung (retiring in March 2025).
