Notice of the Annual General Meeting 2026

The **Annual General Meeting (AGM)** will be held on the 28th March 2026, 7 pm at the main sanctuary of Yishun Christian Church (Anglican) 10 Yishun Avenue 5, Singapore 768991. Dinner will be served from 5.30 pm onwards at the iZone.

The business of the AGM is to receive the minutes of the previous AGM, a copy of the electoral roll, the annual report of the Parochial Church Council and the audited financial statements. We will also be electing the People's Warden, Synod Representatives and 7 council members of the Parochial Church Council. We will need to appoint the auditor for the church and approve the 2025 Church Budget.

For any other business (AOB) to be tabled for discussion at the AGM, it must be submitted to the Vicar a week prior to the AGM for his review.

ANNUAL REVISION AND INSPECTION OF THE CHURCH ELECTORAL ROLL

Under the Constitution of the Diocese of Singapore (Schedule A, Article 15), the Vicar is required to annually revise and bring the church electoral roll up to date by: 1) deletion of the names of those who no longer possess the required qualifications to be on the electoral roll and by 2) addition of the names of members who fulfil the conditions to be on the electoral roll and submitting the online application for enrolment on the electoral roll.

Criteria for determining the inclusion/ deletion of the names on the YCCA electoral roll:

- Communicant member^[1] of the Anglican Church.
- Regularity of worship at services in YCCA.
- Participation in the life and ministry of YCCA through stewardship of time, talents, and regular financial contributions to the work of the Church in YCCA.

- Involvement as electoral roll member for at least one of the last three AGMs through signing of the electoral roll or attendance of the AGM.

From Sunday, 8th March 2026 until Sunday, 22nd March 2025, a revised electoral roll for 2026 will be made available for inspection onsite before the service near the entrance of the main sanctuary and after the service at iZone. It will also be made available in the YCCA office during office hours 9 am to 5 pm, Tuesday to Friday and 9am-1pm on Saturday.

If your name is not on the electoral roll because you have not applied to be on the church electoral roll or have been deleted from the church electoral roll, you can apply to be enrolled on the electoral roll by submitting the electoral roll application. You can do this by providing your name and email address in order for you to receive the email to fill up the electoral roll application digitally. The Diocese of Singapore has digitalised its membership procedures. Application through hard copies to be part of the electoral roll is no longer available. Your enrolment to the electoral roll is subjected to the conditions stated on the enrolment application form and the approval of the Vicar.

NOMINATION FOR THE PAROCHIAL CHURCH COUNCIL

Nominations for the People's Warden, Synod Representatives and 7 council members of the Parochial Church Council will commence on Sunday, 8th March 2026, and will be closing on Sunday, 22nd March 2025 at 12 pm. You may obtain the nomination form(s) from the admin office. Please note that only members who are on the electoral roll are eligible to nominate and to be nominated.

^[1] A communicant member as defined by Schedule A [Article 15] of the Constitution of the Diocese of Singapore shall mean a person who has received Holy Communion according to the use of the Anglican Church or of a Church in communion with it at least 3 times within the 12 months preceding the signing of the Electoral Roll.
